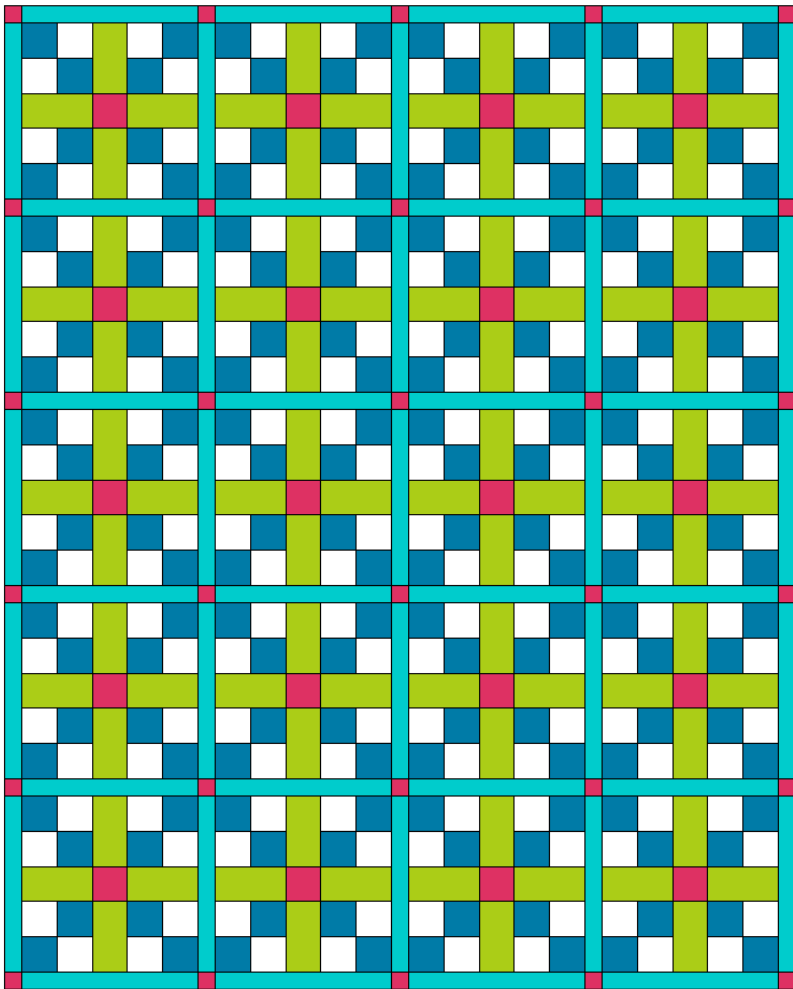


# VALLEY BATIK PLAID

Fabric 1 Pink—Cut 20 (2 1/2" squares) and cut 30 (1 1/2" squares)

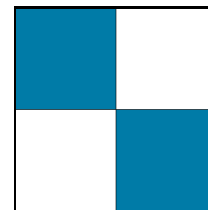
Fabric 2 White—Cut 160 (2 1/2" squares)

Fabric 3 Dark Blue—Cut 160 (2 1/2" squares)

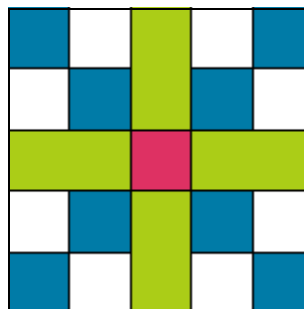
Fabric 4 Green—Cut 80 (2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles)

Fabric 5 Turquoise—Cut 49 (1 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips for sashing)

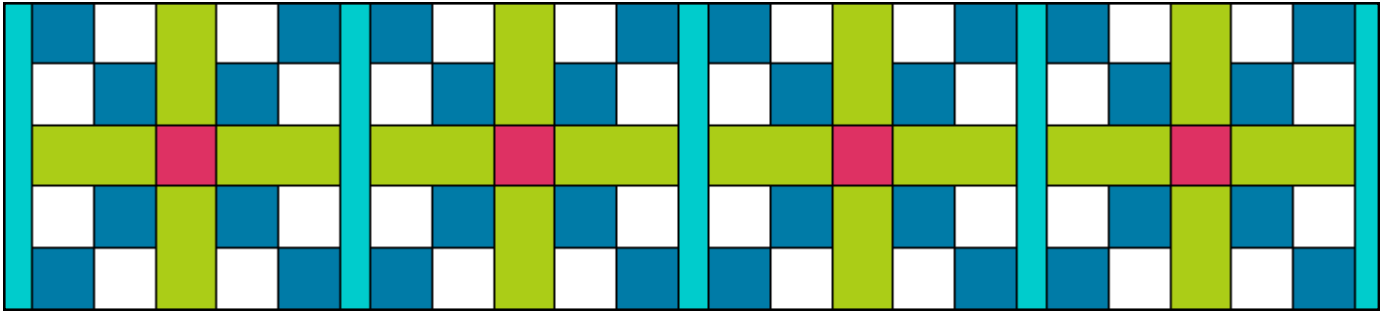
1. Sew together all the blue and white squares into 4 patches.



2. Assemble 20 blocks and press.



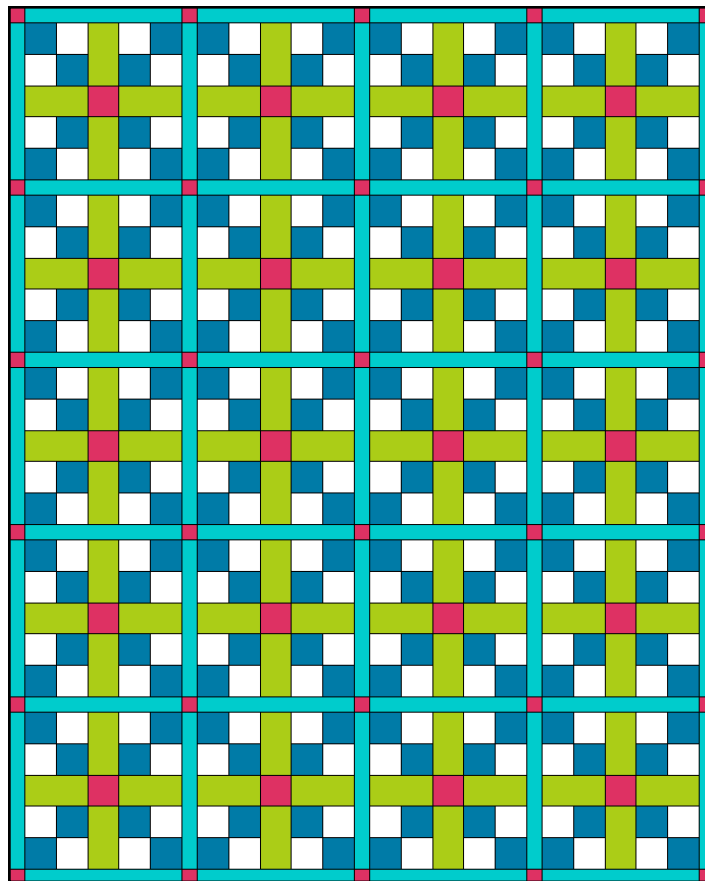
3. Sew to each side of block a turquoise strip. Sew together into five rows.



4. Make 6 rows of turquoise and pink.



5. Sew together rows and quilt as desired. Use remainder of fabric for binding. I used the turquoise fabric.
